Reach and Connect is a project under the Florida Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program (BCCEDP). This project provides education and support to for Bay, Calhoun, Franklin, Gulf, Holmes, Jackson, Liberty, Walton & Washington counties. Areas in those counties have been identified as having higher rates of late stage diagnosed breast and cervical cancer cases. Your local Community Health Worker will provide toolkit training, follow ups, resources and support to connect women to services and reduce barriers to screening.
